News from the Office

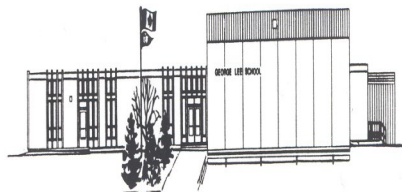
